On the 22nd day of December, 2011, at 8:00 a.m., a regular meeting of the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District was held in Sarita, Texas, at the Kenedy County Courthouse.

1. Call Meeting to Order

Chuck Burns, President, called the meeting to order at 8:00 am.

2. Public Comments

No public comments were received.

3. Discuss & Act on Minutes of November 16, 2011 Meeting

Chuck Burns, President, presented to the Board of Directors the Minutes of the November 16, 2011, regular meeting of the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District.

Homero Vera moved and David Delaney seconded the motion; the motion was unanimously passed that the minutes from the November 16, 2011, regular meeting be accepted as presented.

4. Receive Report on Registration and Permitting Program and Act, If Necessary

Mary Sahs reported that no new wells had been registered since the last meeting. She also reported on progress being made on acquiring needed coordinates for various wells that have been registered with the District. Ms. Sahs provided an update on the status of the District's database and on training being provided to Andy Garza.

In reference to water quality reports being submitted to the District, Ms. Sahs reported that most reflected data was on treated, rather than raw water. It was recommended that Rule 5 be modified to show the need to report raw water data only.

Mary Sahs reported that reminder letters on water usage reports have been sent to permit holders and owners/operators of temporary rig supply wells.

Following a recommendation from Mary Sahs, David Delaney moved and Homero Vera seconded the motion; the motion was unanimously passed that ExxonMobil be sent a letter reminding ExxonMobil that their water quality reports are overdue.

5. Discuss and Act on the Following Operating Permit Applications:

a. Applicant: LMBI, L.P.

Permit No. 2011-003

Location: La Paloma Ranch-Kleberg County

Production and Use: Irrigation of Coastal Bermuda grass on 331 acres; 2069

Acre-feet per year

b. Applicant: LMBI, L.P.

Permit No. 2011-004

Location: La Paloma Ranch-Kenedy County

Production and Use: Irrigation of crops used for feed for livestock and wild-

life on 180 acres; 675 acre-feet per year

Mary Sahs presented and recommended to the Board of Directors the approval of the LMBI, LP's well operating permit application #2011-003.

Homero Vera moved and David Delaney seconded the motion; the motion was unanimously passed that LMBI, L.P.'s Application for a Well Operating Permit #2011-003 be approved and the permit be granted; that Chuck Burns is authorized to sign the Order and Permit and David Delaney is authorized to attest the Order; and that the Permit becomes effective January 2, 2012, if a request for a contested case hearing is not filed.

Mary Sahs presented and recommended to the Board of Directors the approval of the LMBI, LP's well operating permit application #2011-004.

David Delaney moved and Homero Vera seconded the motion; the motion was unanimously passed that LMBI, L.P.'s Application for a Well Operating Permit #2011-004 be approved and the permit be granted; that Chuck Burns is authorized to sign the Order and Permit

and David Delaney is authorized to attest the Order; and that the Permit becomes effective January 2, 2012, if a request for a contested case hearing is not filed.

6. Receive Report on Status and Schedule for Updating District's Management Plan

Mary Sahs reported the progress being made in updating the District's Management Plan. She stated that Andy Garza and Dr. Venkatesh Uddameri are assisting her with the update and that the goal is to submit a draft plan approved by the Board of Directors to the TWDB for a preliminary review, no later than April 2, 2012.

This being a report only, no vote was needed and none taken.

7. Discuss and Act on GMA-16 Joint Planning and Desired Future Conditions

Andy Garza provided the Board of Directors with information on hydrostatic levels to bottom of screen depths for various wells in the District. Mr. Garza noted that this information, according to Bill Hutchinson, could be useful in determining DFC for GMA-16 and the District.

Andy Garza presented the proposed agenda for the upcoming GMA-16 meeting on January 17, 2012 in Falfurrias, Texas. After some discussion, David Delaney moved and Homero Vera seconded the motion; the motion was unanimously passed to add the following items to the agenda: 1. report on historical pumping values from member GCDS, 2. status on willingness of GCDs to provide financial assistance for model runs, 3. development of scope of work needed to hire consultant, 4. status on district management plans and 5. receive report from Mary Sahs on TWDB groundwater rulemaking meeting.

8. Receive Presentation by Dr. Venkatesh Uddameri Regarding Pumping Values for Use in GMA-16 Joint Planning, and Possible Action on Recommendation

Dr. Venkatesh Uddameri presented the Board of Directors with historical, current and future groundwater use in the Kenedy County GCD. To estimate long-term groundwater use, Dr. Uddameri used 2012 state water plan numbers and current surface water/groundwater use ratios for the counties in the district. The ratio was then used to predict future groundwater demands. The projected rate of change in groundwater use is 500 acre-feet per year. No significant differences were noted in the short-term with different multipliers.

Dr. Uddameri informed the Board of Directors that the next step in the process will be to look at spatial distribution and use factors such as aquifer thickness, proximity to demand centers, water quality and existing groundwater users as criteria.

This being a work session only, no vote was needed and none was taken.

9. <u>Discuss and Act on Proposed Contract with Dr. Venkatesh Uddameri Regarding His Appearance at the November 2011 Board Meeting; Compiling Pumping Values for GMA-16 DFC Planning; Developing Rationale for Different Desired Future Conditions for GMA-16; Answer the Board's Questions About Historical Use; and Provide Language for Proposed Rule 4.5, Not to Exceed \$5,000.00</u>

Mary Sahs reviewed with the Board of Directors the following tasks to be included in Dr. Uddameri's contract: 1) develop suggested pumping values for Kenedy County GCD for near-and long-term periods, 2) make presentations to the BOD at its December, 2011 and January, 2012 meetings on pumping values, 3) develop recommendations suggesting distribution patterns for any model runs for GMA-16, 4) develop rationale for different DFCs for updip and downdip areas, 5) attend the January 17th, 2012 meeting to provide technical support on pumping values decisions made by BOD and 6) attend one additional GMA-16 meeting to provide technical support of pumping decisions, distribution patterns, and rationale for different DFCs for updip and downdip areas.

This being a report only, no vote was needed and none was taken.

10. Conduct Rulemaking Work Session, and Act, If Necessary

Mary Sahs led the discussion on the following proposed rule revisions. Proposed language for new rule 4.5 was covered in depth. Rule 4.5 pertains to the minimum depth that a well should be completed (500 feet) and the basis for seeking party status to request a Contested Case Hearing on an operating permit. Revisions to Rule 5, Reporting and Recordkeeping, Rule 8, Procedural Rules and Rule 9, Water Wells Associated With Uranium Exploration and Mining were also reviewed and received input from the directors.

This being a work session only, no vote was needed and none was taken.

11. <u>Discuss and Act on Identification and Approval of Water Wells to be Added to the Monitoring Well Project Beginning with the January 2012 Measuring Event Under the District's Monitoring Well Project</u>

Andy Garza informed the Board of Directors that he had contacted the Kenedy Charitable Trust and the Kenedy Memorial Foundation about monitoring additional wells for water levels in the northeast corner of Kenedy County along the coast. At least one well will be monitored on the Laureles Division in Nueces County and a well on La Paloma Ranch will be considered for monitoring.

Regarding well monitoring, the Board of Directors and Mary Sahs suggested that the data being collected be superimposed on the district map. Dr. Uddameri offered assistance on this matter.

This being a report only, no vote was needed and none was taken.

12. <u>Discuss and Act on Water Quality Parameters to be Sampled and Number of Wells Subject to Water Quality Sampling During the January 2012 Measuring Event Under the District's Monitoring Well Project</u>

Andy Garza informed the Board of Directions regarding the new water testing meter that was recently purchased by the District. It can measure pH, temperature, electrical conductivity and total dissolved solids. It will be used during the next water level measurement event. Approximately 20 wells will be sampled. Mr. Garza recommended that the District wait until it receives a preliminary report from TAMUK on its water sampling project before it embarks on a comprehensive water quality sampling project of its own. The results from the uranium sampling project will also be considered.

This being a report only, no vote was needed and none was taken.

13. Receive Report on Texas Alliance of Groundwater Districts Meeting Including Committee Meeting on Setting Legislative Agenda, and Act, If Necessary

Andy Garza reported to the Board of Directors that he had attended the November 29-30, 2011, TAGD meeting in Austin. He summarized and reviewed Dr. Neil Wilkins with the Texas Water Resources Institute's presentation on water security for Texas.

Mary Sahs reported on a joint meeting of the Bylaws and Legislative Committees of TAGD that she had attended on November 30, 2011 in Austin.

This being a report only, no vote was needed and none was taken.

14. <u>Discuss and Act on Monthly Posting an Agenda Regarding Electronic and Xerox Communications Among and Between the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District's Board of Directors, Legal Counsel and Staff</u>

Leo Villarreal informed the Board of Directors that the Directors could inadvertently violate the Open Meetings Act through electronic communications amongst the Directors and staff.

Homero Vera moved and David Delaney seconded the motion; the motion unanimously passed that Leo Villarreal seek an Attorney General's opinion on this matter.

15. Receive Update on District Audit as per State Auditor's Office

Leo Villarreal and Andy Garza informed the Board of Directors that all requests for information from the State Auditor's Office have been timely provided.

Leo Villarreal stated that as a result of the audit, there are certain policies that needed to be addressed and that he and Andy Garza would work on them.

This being a report only, no vote was needed and none was taken.

16. <u>Discuss and Act on Need for Additional Office Space to Accommodate District Operations</u>

Andy Garza reported to the Board of Directors that he had outgrown his office space. Leo Villarreal informed the Board of Directors that he had visited with Judge Turcotte about the matter and that the Judge has recommended that the district office be moved to Courthouse office that at one time housed the County Attorney on the first floor; that the County Commissioners' Court in January, 2012 would address authorization of the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District's use of the former County Attorney office at the Courthouse and to retain the District's present office for storage of the District's records.

Mary Sahs commented that the District may consider clerical assistance for the General Manager sometime in the future.

David Delaney moved and Homero Vera seconded the motion; the motion unanimously passed to request the Kenedy County Commissioners' Court for a lease allowing the District the use of the former County Attorney office at the Courthouse and retaining the present office.

17. <u>Discuss and Act on Credit Card Application</u>

Andy Garza presented to the Board of Directors the VISA credit card application with a credit limit of \$1,000.00.

Homero Vera moved and David Delaney seconded the motion; the motion was unanimously passed that the District submit to Kleberg Bank the VISA credit card application.

18. <u>Discuss and Act on Purchasing 2012 Minute Hylson Book</u>

Leo Villarreal informed the Board of Directors that it was necessary to purchase the 2012 Minute Hylson Book in an amount not to exceed \$286.00.

David Delaney moved and Homero Vera seconded the motion; the motion was unanimously passed that a Hylson Minute Book be purchased for the 2012 Minutes at a cost not to exceed \$286.00.

19. Receive Report on 2012 Elections

Leo Villarreal reminded the Board of Directors that Chuck Burns and Daniel Butler would be up for reelection in 2012 and Craig Weiland in 2014.

This being a report only, no vote was needed and none was taken.

20. <u>Discuss and Act on Appointing Craig Weiland as Director for Precinct 2 Effective</u> January 2012

Leo Villarreal informed the Board of Directors that the U. S. Dept of Justice, Voting Section, had precleared Craig Weiland's appointment because it was considered an administrative matter and Craig Weiland could be appointed Director for Precinct 2 effective January 1, 2012. Precinct 2 had been vacant since Jerry Miller resigned in March, 2011.

David Delaney moved and Homero Vera seconded the motion; the motion was unanimously passed to appoint Craig Weiland as Director for Precinct 2 of the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District effective January 1, 2012.

21. <u>Hold Public Hearing on Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District's</u> Proposed Redistricting Plan

Chuck Burns, at 11:18 a.m., announced that the public hearing on the District's proposed redistricting plan was now in session and welcomed members of the public to address the board regarding the proposed plan.

No member of the public addressed the Board of Directors regarding the District's proposed Redistricting Plan. Chuck Burns closed the public hearing at 11:20 a.m.

22. <u>Discuss and Act on the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District's Redistricting Plan</u>

Chuck Burns and Leo Villarreal presented the Board of Directors the proposed Redistricting Map and Plan for the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District. They informed the Board of Directors that:

- Precinct 1 had 139 residents from Kenedy County and the Laureles Ranch
- Precinct 2 had 140 residents from Kenedy and Kleberg County and Santa Gertrudis ISD
- Precinct 3 had 139 residents from Kenedy, Willacy, Brooks & Hidalgo Counties
- Precinct 4 had 140 residents from Kenedy and Willacy County
- Precinct 5 had 137 residents from Jim Wells County and the Santa Gertrudis ISD.

David Delaney moved and Homero Vera seconded the motion; the motion was unanimously passed that the proposed Redistricting Plan be adopted and presented to the U. S. Department of Justice for approval as per the following resolutions and orders:

RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE KENEDY COUNTY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT'S PLAN AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO

BE IT RESOLVED that the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District's Board of Directors is authorized to issue an Order, effective December 31, 2011, terminating and declaring null and void the November 4, 2004, original Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District Plan as amended on May 1, 2008 and April 15, 2010.

ORDER TERMINATING THE KENEDY COUNTY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT ORIGINAL PLAN AND SUBSEQUENT PLANS THERETO

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, effective December 31, 2011, the original November 4, 2004, Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District Plan as amended on May 1, 2008 and April 15, 2010, is hereby terminated and held null and void.

Upon motion duly made by Director David Delaney and seconded by Director Homero Vera, the following Resolution and Order were unanimously adopted and issued:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors is hereby authorized to adopt the Gary Don Hopkins Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District 2011 Reapportionment Plan effective January 1, 2012; that the Kenedy County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors Precincts be numbered and redefined by metes and bounds; that the fourteen polling places be numbered and redefined as described below; that a 2011 Reapportionment Map be prepared in accordance with the below metes and bounds as described below and to be displayed in the Kenedy County Courthouse; and that the 2011 Reapportionment Plan be submitted to the U. S. Department of Justice for pre-clearance.

S. Department of Justice for pre-clearance.

THE KENEDY COUNTY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT 2011 REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF VOTING PRECINCTS

VOTING PRECINCT 1

BEGINNING at the northwest corner of the "Los Sauces" Grant to Jose Antonio Ynojosa (A-240) in Kleberg County, Texas, also being the place of intersection of the centerline of San Fernando Creek with the south boundary of Nueces County (also being a north boundary of Kleberg County);

THENCE Easterly with the said north boundary of the "Los Sauces" Grant and said common Nueces - Kleberg County line, passing the northeast corner of the said "Los Sauces" Grant and crossing the west boundary of the "El Chiltipin" Grant to Blas Maria Falcon (A-92), and continuing with said common Nueces — Kleberg County line to the most westerly corner of a certain triangular "1168 acres" tract (described in an Oil, Gas and Mineral Lease from Mrs. Henrietta M. King Estate, et al, to Humble Oil and Refining Company, dated September 26, 1933, and recorded in Volume 37, Page 183, of the Deed Records of Kleberg County, Texas) for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE East-northeasterly direction with the northwesterly boundary of said "1168 acres" tract to its intersection with the centerline of Petronilla Creek (formerly called Agua Dulce Creek) for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE with the meanders of the said centerline of creek in a Southeasterly direction to its intersection with the above mentioned common Nueces – Kleberg County line for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Easterly with said common Nueces – Kleberg County Line, to the southwest corner of Section 124 of the Laureles Farm Tracts Subdivision (Cabinet A, Slides 77G and 97D, Plat Records of Nueces County) for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Northerly with the west boundaries of Sections 124, 103, 88, 67, 53, and 32 to the northwest corner of the south one-half of said Section32 for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Easterly with the north boundaries of the south one half of Section 32 and of Section 54A to an intersection with the southern shoreline of Cayo Del Oso for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE with the meanders of the said shoreline in a generally Easterly direction to its intersection with the northwesterly boundary of a certain 1999.96 acres tract (as described in a Warranty Deed from King Ranch, Inc., to American General Life Insurance of Delaware, dated December 28, 1970, and recorded in Volume 1386, Page 193, of the Deed Records of Nueces County) for a corner of this Precinct No. 1);

THENCE Southwesterly with the said northwest boundary of the 1999.96 acres tract to the westernmost corner of said tract, for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Southeasterly with the southwestern boundary of the 1999.96 acre tract to its intersection with the shoreline of the Laguna Madre;

THENCE in a generally South-southwesterly direction with the meanders of the shoreline of the Laguna Madre to the headland where the shoreline of the Laguna Madre becomes the shoreline of Baffin Bay;

THENCE in a generally Southwesterly direction with the meanders of Baffin Bay to an intersection with a line projected North (geodetic) from an angle point in the common southern boundary of Kleberg County and northern boundary of Kenedy County in Baffin Bay at Latitude N 27° 16' 00.03" and Longitude W 97° 30' 28.48" NAD83 (as scaled from said angle point in Baffin Bay as said angle point is shown on U.G.S. 7 ½ minute quadrangle map Kleberg Point), said place of intersection being a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE South (geodetic) to the said angle point in said common Kleberg – Kenedy county line for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE East-northeasterly with the said common boundary of Kleberg and Kenedy Counties (said boundary being shown on U.S.G.S. 7 ½ minute quadrangle maps Kleberg Point and Point of Rocks), to an angle point in said boundary at Latitude N 27° 16' 40.68" and Longitude W 97° 25' 27.42" NAD83 (scaled from said quad map Point of Rocks) for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Easterly with said common boundary (said common boundary being shown on quad maps Point of Rocks and South Bird Island SE) to its intersection with the shoreline of the Gulf of Mexico at approximately Latitude N 27° 16' 40.44" and Longitude W 97° 20' 51.42" NAD83 (scaled from said map South Bird Island SE) for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Southerly with the meanders of the shoreline of the Gulf of Mexico to an intersection with an Easterly extension of the common boundary between the "Rincon De Mirasoles" Grant to Ignacio Villareal (on the north) and the "La Barreta" (Little Barreta) Grant to Leonardo Salinas (on the south), said place of intersection being for the southeast corner of this Voting Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Westerly with said projection of common boundary and with said common boundary to the southwest corner of the "Rincon De Mirasoles" Grant, for a corner of this Precinct No. 1 (said southwest corner also being the southeast corner of the "El Palmito" Grant to Miguel Ynojosa);

THENCE Northerly with the western boundary of the "Rincon De Mirasoles" Grant and the eastern boundary of the "El Palmito" Grant, to the northeast corner of the "El Palmito" Grant, for a corner of this Precinct No. 1 (said northeast corner also being the southeast corner of the "San Pedro De Las Motas" Grant to Xavier Salinas);

THENCE Westerly with the northern boundary of the "El Palmito" Grant and the southern boundary of the "San Pedro De Las Motas" Grant, to the northwest corner of the "El Palmito" Grant and the southwest corner of the "San Pedro De Las Motas" Grant (also being the southeast corner of the "Las Barrosas" Grant to Irineo Gomez) for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Northerly with the eastern boundary of the "Las Barrosas" Grant and the western boundary of the "San Pedro De Las Motas" Grant, passing the northwest corner of the "San Pedro De Las Motas" Grant (also being the southwest corner of the "La Parra" Grant to Domingo and Albino De La Garza) and continuing northerly with the eastern boundary of the "Las Barrosas" Grant and the western boundary of the "La Parra" Grant, to the northeast corner of the "Las Barrosas" Grant (also being the southeast corner of the "El Paistle" Grant to Juan Antonio Balli), for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Westerly with the northern boundary of "Las Barrosas" Grant and the southern boundary of the "El Paistle" Grant, to an intersection with the western right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 77, for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE in a Northerly direction with the said western right-of-way line to an intersection with the centerline of La Parra Avenue of Sarita Townsite (according to a map or plat of Sarita Townsite recorded in Volume 1, Page 26, of the Plat Records of Kenedy County), for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Westerly with the centerline of La Parra Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of Main Street of Sarita Townsite, for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Northerly with the centerline of Main Street to an intersection with an extension of the north right-of-way line of Kenedy Avenue (crossing Main Street) for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Easterly with said extension across Main Street to the southwest corner of Lot 9 of Block 36 of said Townsite and continuing easterly with the south boundary of said Lot 9 to the southeast corner of Lot 9 for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Northerly with the east boundaries of Lots 9 through 16 (inclusive) to the northeast corner of Lot 16 of Block 36 of said Townsite, for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Westerly with the north boundary of said Lot 16 of Block 36 (and the south right-of-way line of Weiss Avenue (formerly Willacy Avenue) passing the northwest corner of said Lot 16, crossing Main Street to the northeast corner of Lot 1 of Block 35 of said Townsite, continuing with the north boundary of said Lot 1 to its northwest corner, crossing the alley in said Block 35 to the northeast corner of Lot 16 of Block 35, continuing with the north boundary of said Lot 16 to its northwest corner, and crossing Mallory Street of said Townsite to the northeast corner of Lot 1 of Block 34 of said Townsite for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Southerly with the east boundaries of Lots 1 through 6 (inclusive) and the north one-half of Lot 7 (also with the west right-of-way line of Mallory Street) to the northeast corner of the north one-half of Lot 7 of Block 34 for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Westerly with the north boundary of the north one-half of said Lot 7 to the northwest corner of the north one-half of Lot 7 for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;

THENCE Southerly with the west boundaries of the north one-half of said Lot 7 and of Lot 8 to the southwest corner of Lot 8 of Block 34 for a corner of this Precinct No. 1;
