#### 1. Call Meeting to Order

Edward Bordovsky, President, called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM and announced that a quorum was present.

### 2. Public Comments

Andy Garza introduced those in the audience who normally do not attend GCD meetings.

#### 3. Discuss & Act on Minutes of November 20, 2024 Regular Meeting

Edward Bordovsky presented the Directors with the November 20, 2024 regular meeting minutes.

Justin Cantu moved and Esteban Lopez seconded the motion; the motion unanimously passed to approve the minutes of the November 20, 2024 regular meeting.

Andy Garza, General Manager, reported on the following:

- a. Communications: Garza reported that since the District's November 20, 2024 meeting, he had communicated with Joe Stiles, Kenedy Charitable Trust liaison, regarding registration of P-13 water well; Joe Strack, J4 Water Wells rep, regarding the registration of water well on behalf of Posillico Co.; Dr. Dorina Murgulet, TAMCC professor, regarding a presentation to be made at the GCD December, 2024 meeting; Antonio Delgado, TWDB data manager, regarding completion of 2022 irrigation survey and Dave Delaney, ranch consultant, regarding the Alluvium Aquifer as per the Hacienda Alegre Ranch in southern Kenedy County.
- b. Well registrations: Garza informed the Directors that J & S Water Wells had registered a water well for the Posillico Co.
